Please be at Seaton Burn services fuelled up for 9.30am to be in time for the ride briefing and prompt departure of the first group at 10.00am. ***(It would be a good idea to bring a flask and a sandwich for lunch at Hutton Le Hole as the cafes and pub may be busy)***

10am	Depart Seaton Burn Services South on the A19 through the Tyne Tunnel Continue South on the A19	
10.45	Arrive at the A19 American Diner Coffee and Bacon Sandwich stop!	35
11.15	Continue South on the A19 over the Tees Flyover Keep left for the A174 signposted to Whitby Continue on the A174 turning right at the Yearby roundabout signposted Guisborough B1269 Turn right briefly at the next roundabout on the A173 then left onto the A171 signposted to Whitby Climb steeply up Birk Brow hill up onto the North York Moors After a mile turn right onto an unmarked road signposted to Castleton <i>(Take care on the narrow road leading into Castleton itself and beware of the adverse camber when turning right at the T Junction up hill on the way to Hutton Le Hole)</i>	
12.15	Arrive at Hutton Le Hole Lunch stop <i>(Park in the North York Moors National Park car park on the left)</i>	80
1.15	Continue south to Kirkbymoorside on the A170 Petrol Stop, Jet garage Continue west on the A170 to Helmsley turning left at the Market Square <i>(Proceed with care down Sutton Bank (1:4) with a hairpin bend)</i>	83

- 2.00** Arrive at Thirsk, turn right then left into the car park **102**
Tea break
- 2.45** Leave Thirsk on the A168 to Northallerton
Continue north through Northallerton on the A167 turning right just past Great Smeaton onto the B1264 signposted for Yarm
Turn right at the Kirklevington roundabout onto the A67 joining the A19 northbound after 2 miles
(Take care as this is an unusual slip road approach)
- 4.00** Continue north on the A19 to the Shell Easington Services **152**
Ride Ends
- Please note; be aware of sheep and lambs grazing and wandering across the road on the North York Moors, (They don't know the Green Cross Code!). Also the farmers are very busy at this time of the year so be aware of tractors and farm machinery on the roads and turning in and out of fields.***
