

Return Journey – assemble at museum for 3pm (approx) departure

Turn left out of the museum on Stockton Lane for 0.5 mile.

Turn right onto Hopgrove Lane for 0.4 mile.

Turn right onto Malton Road / A1036.

At roundabout take the 3rd exit onto A 1237 for 0.2 mile.

At the Hopgrove roundabout take the 1st exit onto the A64 for 7.4 miles.

Turn left towards Slingsby Hovingham. Within a few hundred feet take the next left, next right and next right onto Mains Lane, in the direction of Castle Howard, which you should pass on your right side.

Mains Lane becomes Slingsby Bank and ends at a T junction with the B1257.

Turn left onto the B1257 and drive on through Hovingham.

5 miles out of Hovingham turn right at sign for Nunnington and Kirbymoorside.

Continue on road towards Wombledon (Yes, Wombledon!).

As you approach Wombledon, turn right at the sign for Kirbymoorside.

At the A170 Turn right.

Petrol and toilets stop at Jet petrol station (YO62 6DG) on A170 at Kirbymoorside on left (approx 120 miles).

From Kirbymoorside continue in the direction of Pickering then take the left turn to Hutton le hole (Grey Lane).

Continue, in the direction of Castleton, on Grey Lane which becomes Yan Brow (I'm not making up any of these names!) through Hutton Le Hole onto Keld Lane, which becomes Blakely Road (None of these roads/lanes appear to have numbers).

Continue towards Castleton (Blakely Road becomes Stepin Turn).

Enjoy the open roads over the moors, but keep a sharp eye out for sheep and cyclists.

Head into Castleton on the High Street to a sharp left hand bend leading you out of the village on Smeathorns Road for approx 5 miles to the A171.

Turn left onto the A171. Keep an eye on the posted speed limits. Continue on the A171 towards Nunthorpe.

Take the A1043 (2nd exit at the Nunthorpe roundabout)

At the next roundabout take the 2nd exit in the direction of Middlesbrough.

Keep straight on until the junction with the A174. Turn left down the sliproad and join the dual carriageway.

Continue along the A174 to the roundabout with the A19.

Take A19 north (3rd exit) to services at Elwick (TS27 3HH) 15.5 miles

End of rideout.
