

Mountain Views and Fish 'n' Chips

First ride out of the season is a jaunt through Northumberland taking in some of the roads highlighted in the recent club survey. Roads such as the B6343, the B6341, a stretch of the A696, the B6348. All lovely roads with great views all the way.

Leaving Seaton Burn we will take the Old Great North Road, left on the Berwick Hill road. Left on Green Lane past signposted to the Cheese Farm. Follow this road to Tranwell. Then over the main road towards Mitford where we pick up the B6343 to Cambo. On towards Knowesgate, pick up the A696 north to Raylees where we turn right for Elsdon. On to Rothbury for morning cuppa.

Rothbury back to Thropton, turn right and head for Powburn via, Callalay and Glanton. Follow A697 to Chatton turn, on to Bamburgh and Seahouses for lunch.

Meander back to Seaton Burn via the Coastal Route and the A1068 through Sheepwash, Choppington and Bedlington.

127 miles only. Fuel on the A1 at 73 miles.
